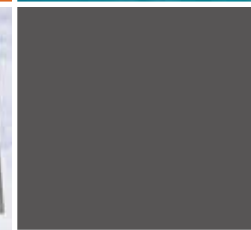

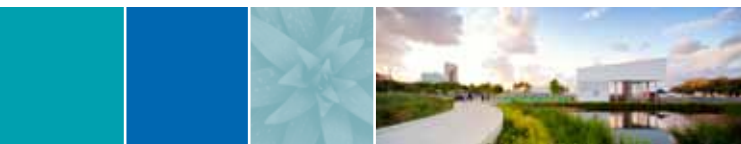

Maximum of two presenters per abstract may register at the subsidised fee.
